

# Tokyo Video Festival **2017** Entry Regulation

## The characteristics of Tokyo Video Festival 2017

### **【Free themes & genres! Any & all applicants are welcome!】**

Video must be 20 minutes long including the title & credits. Free themes and genres.

There are no restrictions on applicant's age, gender, nationality, occupation, types of equipment (any video camera and iPhone), production methods. (TVF office must be able to hold the right to watch, edit, broadcast, use the work for NPO activities, show on internet.)

### **【Applications are free of charge】**

There are no application fees.

### **【No. of prize winners are unlimited】**

Number of prize winners will not be limited prior to judgement on all applied video works.

"TVF 2017 award" will be selected from all applications (submitted before 31st of October, 2016).

And all video works will be introduced on our web site accordingly.

Furthermore, "Grand Prize" will be selected from all the applications on "Judgement open to public" by TVF judges at the Forum which is scheduled to be held in Tokyo, in January, 2017.

| Application qualifications | There are no restrictions on applicant's age, gender, nationality, or occupation.  |
| Application regulations    | <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The themes, genres or production methods are free.</li><li>2. Video must be 20 minutes long including the title and the credits.<br/>The starting and the end point must be clearly marked with insertion of black or color bar for longer than 5 seconds.</li><li>3. There are no restrictions on types of equipment used to create the video work. Any video cameras, digital cameras and i-phones are permitted.<br/>There are no regulations on types of recording devices either. DVD, blue-ray, SD card and movie files (.mp4) which can be submitted via e-mail, are allowed. However, the works must be watched, edited and broadcasted by the head office.</li></ol> |

|                                | <p>4. Year of production must be shown in the video works. Applications may already have been published or unpublished.</p> <p>5. Any award winning works or videos that have already been submitted to other festivals are welcome as well.</p> <p>6. Video works with language, other than Japanese, must contain Japanese or English subtitles.</p> <p>7. All entries must be usable for activities by our NPO for the promotion of film culture of the people and the development of the society. (Activities include screening, seminar, forum, publicity overseas, collections of works and advertising.) Rights to make duplicate copy and editing of the video works must be included as well.</p> <p>8. All applicants must take full responsibility, while creating and publicizing their works, the copyrights, one's consent for publicity rights and any other Succession to Rights and Obligations, and treat them accordingly.</p> <p>9. All works must not include contents which are contrary to public order or morality, or mental abuse or slander or a breach of privacy of a particular individual, or because of dispute. (The entry of such work will be refused or eliminated if and when the head office decides the it is inappropriate.)</p> |
| <p>Method for application</p>  | <p>【Application forms】 (forms need to be downloaded from our web site.)<br/> Attach and send an application form saved on a recording device, per video work. Furthermore, when submitting a work on movie files (.mp4) via e-mail, attach an application form with the entry (or send each one separately) to [npotvinfo@gmail.com]</p>   |
